

EASIAM Student Paper Competition Call for Submission

The next awards will be presented in the 6th EASIAM Annual Meeting to be held from **June 22 until June 24, 2010** at University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Principal Guidelines

The EASIAM (East Asia Society of Industrial and Applied Mathematics) Student Paper Prizes are awarded every year to the student author(s) of the most outstanding paper(s) submitted to the EASIAM Student Paper Competition. This award is based solely on the merit and content of the student's contribution in the submitted paper.

The **purpose** of the Student Paper Prizes is to recognize outstanding scholarship by students in applied mathematics or computing.

Requirements for Submission

To enter the competition, each applicant

- must be a student of a country in East or Southeast Asia;
- must not attend the oral defense before August 15, 2009;
- and must submit a short vitae including his/her list of publications (at most two pages) and the paper.

The **student's advisor** must submit a letter that describes and evaluates the paper's contribution to the literature and the student's role in the publication.

Notification of Prize Winner(s)

The EASIAM will notify the possible candidates of award recipient(s) around April 15, 2010. Each candidate is required to present his or her paper at the EASIAM meeting where the prizes are determined to award.

Description of the Award

Each recipient of the EASIAM Student Paper Prize shall receive a **certificate** and reimbursement of **up to US\$250** toward travel expenses. Up to four awards will be made each year.
